A classic Hunter Valley Semillon showing a tightly structured palate with considerable length and breadth of citrus fruit flavours.

- 062 **Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2008**, New Zealand 32.00

character. The perfect partner for all sticky puddings.
